

<u>Sacrament</u>

What is a sacrament?

Latin 'sacramentum' meaning 'oath' (mystery)

<u>Sacramentum</u>

"A Mystery of God's salvation ... symbols and rites associated with this salvation in the life of – Tertullian the church"

"Visible sign of invisible grace" - Augustine Imprecise, no agreement **Except ... Eucharist / Baptism**

"Sanctifying & Signifying ...a form of invisible grace and exists as its cause" - Peter Lombard The Sacraments (AD 1150)

<u>Sacrament</u>

"An outward sign by which the Lord seals on our consciences the promise of his good will in order to sustain our faith ..." - John Calvin




