



Objectives


High-level introduction to the feasts and holidays of the Old Testament which unveil God's redemptive plan and serve as a shadow of the things to come, the substance found in Christ.

Leviticus 23:10-11

"...When you come into the land that I give you and reap its harvest, you shall bring the sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the priest, and he shall wave the sheaf before the Lord, so that you may be accepted. On the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it..."



 Day After "HaMatzot" Offering for Spring Barley God's Provision • The First Ripe Sheaf • Third Day (16 Nisan)





"... Already, on the 14th of Nisan, the spot whence the first sheaf was to be reaped had been marked out by delegates from the Sanhedrin, by tying together in bundles ..."









Today, 16 Nisan (Third Day)...

- Rarely Celebrated by Jews
- Always Celebrated by Christians



Leviticus 23:15-16

"From the day after the Sabbath, the day you brought the sheaf of the wave offering, count off seven full weeks. Count off fifty days up to the day after the seventh Sabbath, and then present an offering of new grain to the Lord."

• 3,000 Received Under the New Covenant The "Latter Firstfruits" • The Church (You and Me)

Giving of the Law	Giving of the Spirit
Exodus 19:1–20:20; 32	Acts 2
Spiritual birthday of Israel	Spiritual birthday of the Church
Oral Tradition – About 50 days after the Israelites left Egypt (Ex. 19:1).	Written Eyewitness - 50 days after the Resurrection of Christ.
Fire and noise as God descended on Moses upon Mt. Sinai	Rushing wind and fire as God descended upon the believers.
3,000 people died because of their idolatry (Ex. 32:28).	3,000 people were made spiritually alive because of their belief.
Law given to instruct the Israelites.	Spirit given to guide (et al) the Church — Jews and Gentiles.
