




#### Tabernacle


מִשְׁכִּן (miškān, mishkan)

"dwelling, dwelling place"

A Biblical Theology of God's Presence Among Us


Question: How is God's plan of redemptive history moved forward in the Bible byway of His presence (his dwelling, tabernacling) with us?

#### Creation / The Garden




- "they heard the sound of the Lord walking in the garden ..." (Gen. 3:8a)
- "... they hid themselves from the presence of the Lord" (Gen. 3:8b)

#### Mount Sinai



- "The glory of the Lord dwelt on Mount Sinai ..." (Ex. 24:16)
- "I will make my goodness / presence pass before you ..." (Ex. 33:19)

#### The Tabernacle / TOM




- Exodus Leviticus Numbers
- "I will dwell among the people of Israel and will be their God." (Ex. 29:45)

## The Temple




- Functional, permanent equivalent of the Tabernacle in 957 BC
- "... for the Lord has chosen you to stand in his presence." (2 Chr. 29:6-11)

#### Jesus - Immanuel




- "And the Word became flesh and dwelt (tabernacled) among us." (John 1:14)
- "Do you see these great buildings? Not one stone will be left." (Mark 13:2)

## Church / Holy Spirit

### Eternity




- "... to present you blameless before the presence of his glory." (Jude 24)

### Tragic Scripture


- Sent from Garden (Gen. 3:23)
